COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER (CHW) COURSE

- 13-weeks and consist of 48-hours of online and synchronous (only 3 sessions) learning
- **There are two sessions being offered in Spring 2023**
 - Session 1: 1/5/23 - 4/6/23 (with 3 synchronous virtual sessions on Thursdays)
 - Session 2: 2/22/23 - 5/24/23 (with 3 synchronous virtual sessions on Wednesdays)
- Curriculum includes key concepts of public health, outreach, advocacy, community and individual assessments, social determinants of health, health education, navigating insurance, stages of behavior change, service coordination and more

SCHOLARSHIP

- Idaho State University (ISU) College of Pharmacy will be providing 8 scholarships to support participation in the CHW course
- If selected for this scholarship, you/your pharmacy will receive **\$960 reimbursement** to cover your time (48 hours of time at \$20/hour)
- In order to receive this reimbursement, you must agree to:
 - Provide at least 2 referrals to CDC-recognized programs for diabetes or cardiovascular disease
 - Report referral information to ISU
 - Complete the CHW training program and required evaluations

 - Application requires one-paragraph on your pharmacy's plan for using your CHW training and how your position and CHW-services will be sustained
